Note: Paved County Roads must be bored. Trenching is allowed on unpaved County roads, but applicant will be assessed for repairs, (in addition to the permit fee) at the rate of _____ per square feet.

To receive a permit, Applicants should follow this process:

1. Complete this form
 2. Submit this application to your County Commissioner or to the Road & Bridge Supervisor, 432-837-2714 or (cell) 432-294-0398
 3. Attach a check or money order to this application for \$50.00 payable to Brewster County Treasurer's office / Mark the check "Road & Bridge Crossing Permit"
 4. This application will then be placed on the next Commissioners Court Agenda for approval. You need not be present at that meeting.
 5. This permit is not valid until approved by Commissioners Court. The permit will valid for a period of 120 days; the Road & Bridge Superintendent or Commissioner will notify applicants when approval is given.
 6. All bores must be cased.
 7. Once a permit has been issued, the Brewster County Road & Bridge Department (432-837- 2714 or (cell) 432-294-0398) must be notified by applicant of either boring or trenching at least 48 hours before beginning construction and again upon completion of construction.
 8. Warning signs and traffic control measures must be in place, prior to start of construction. Applicant must coordinate with the Road & Bridge Department regarding signs and traffic control.
- Applicant assumes all responsibility and liability for any and all damages or injuries resulting to County, the public or any other entity whatsoever resulting from Applicants trenching or boring under this Brewster County road, as set out in this permit. In the event of any litigation filed against County as a result of Applicants boring or trenching, Applicant agrees to indemnity and hold _____ The Brewster County Road & Bridge Department.
