

BREWSTER COUNTY BURN BAN LIFTED, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Brewster County has decided to lift the burn ban, effective immediately.

According to the Texas Government Code, the County Judge has the authority to lift the burn ban if a determination is made that drought conditions no longer exist.

While much of the County has received rain over the last several weeks, northern areas continued to remain dry until recently.

Should moisture levels again decrease, Brewster County Commissioners Court has the authority to re-enact the burn ban at any time.
