**ORDER AUTHORIZING FIREWORKS SALES DECEMBER 20, 2017-  
MIDNIGHT TO JANUARY 1, 2018**


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Brewster County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h)(1), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public during a period of December 20, 2017 - Midnight to January 1, 2018; and


WHEREAS, on the 13th day of December, 2017, the Commissioners Court of Brewster County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Brewster County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit Holders during the period beginning December 20, 2017 - Midnight and ending at midnight January 1, 2018, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, January 1, 2018, whichever is earlier.
- b. The sales of fireworks are restricted. Prohibited fireworks include skyrockets with sticks as classified in 49 Code of Federal Regulations, § 173.100(r)(2) in effect on October 1, 1986, and as missiles with fins.
- c. A violation of the order is a Class C misdemeanor.
