1. Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance


Invocation and Pledge were led by Judge Cano.

2. Election Administrator / Amended Canvass of November 5, 2019, Constitutional Amendment Election previously approved on November 12, 2019 / Discussion and appropriate action

Lora Nussbaum, Election Administrator, requested to amend the canvass of November 5, 2019, Constitutional Amendment Election previously approved on November 12, 2019. She said there was a data entry error in the canvass. Mrs. Nussbaum said she will be amending Proposition 4 Precinct 4 and the original count that was done at the original canvass was count For: 96 and the actual count was For: 95. Mrs. Nussbaum said the original canvass was 96 with a total of 190 for a grand total of 875 but it is actually 95 for Election Day total of 523 and grand total of 874 for the amended canvass. Commissioner Ortega moved to amend the Constitution Amendment Election canvass as read. Commissioner Colando seconded the motion; motion passed unanimously.
