Citizens and First Responders in the Tri County Area can now utilize the call center to schedule their testing. Dual language call takers can only take appointments 48hrs in advance.

The number for the call center (512)883-2400. This is a collaborative initiative between DSHS, TDEM, TMD, the RACs (HPP Providers), and the TX EMTF.

**To be eligible for testing, you must have one or more symptoms of COVID-19. Symptoms include:**

- Fever and/or chills
- Fatigue
- Shortness of Breath
- Headaches
- Nasal Congestion
- Cough (Dry or Productive)
- Body aches/muscle or joint pain
- Sore Throat
- Nausea/Vomiting/Diarrhea
- Loss of Taste and/or Smell
