## DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Brewster on the 10th of October, 2023, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from

The loss of one water well critical to providing a source of water to the southern half of Brewster County. South Brewster County is currently running on one well that is insufficient to water requirements of the community. The remaining well is not operating at full capacity and is at risk of failing and

WHEREAS, the Brewster County Judge of Brewster County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAMIED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF BREWSTER COUNTY:

That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Brewster County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Brewster County.

Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.

Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the county emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance. ORDERED this 10th of October, 2023.
